They were introduced in SQL Server version 2005. They are SQL compliant and part of the ANSI SQL 99 specification. A CTE always returns a result set.

Arguments. `expression_name` is a valid identifier for the common table expression. `expression_name` must be different from the name of any other common table expression defined in the same `WITH <common_table_expression>` clause, but `expression_name` can be the same as the name of a base table or view.

We can define this CTE within the execution scope of single SELECT, INSERT, DELETE, or UPDATE statement. The basic syntax behind the CTE in SQL Server is as shown below:
