In academic publishing, the goal of peer review is to assess the quality of articles submitted for publication in a scholarly journal. Before an article is deemed appropriate to be published in a peer-reviewed journal, it must undergo the following process:

An academic or scholarly journal is a periodical publication in which scholarship relating to a particular academic discipline is published. Academic journals serve as permanent and transparent forums for the presentation, scrutiny, and discussion of research. They are usually peer-reviewed or refereed. The example in Fig. 2 illustrates that Research emanates from at least one Question at Hand, and aims for at least one piece of New Knowledge. According to our definition (concept model), you cannot call something Research if it is not aiming for New Knowledge and does not emanate from a Question at Hand. This is the way we define the concept in concept modelling, and this small example only ...
