Inflammatory bowel diseases (IBDs) are chronic disabling conditions. Biologics are licensed to treat moderate-to-severe Crohn's disease (CD) and ulcerative colitis (UC) using randomized controlled trial definitions: a Crohn's Disease Activity Index (CDAI) 1 score of 220 to 450 points (for CD) and a Mayo Score 2 of 6 to 12 points (including an endoscopic subscore of 2 or more points for UC).
